### Phonics Fun at Home: Listen, Move and Learn!

Target Age: 6–8 years

CEFR Level: Pre-A1 to A1

Skills: Listening, Speaking, Early Reading & Writing

#### Learning Objectives

Students will:

- Recognise selected letter names
- Connect the letters to initial sounds of a word
- Match initial phoneme sound to a letter
- Make short sentences to show initial sound of each word
- Practise speaking and pointing to sounds and words
- Write a word beginning with selected letters and draw a matching picture to reinforce sound / letter connections

  - “Where is moon?”


**Part 6: Write and Draw**
